GOLD Information & Where To Find It

Westview GOLD is a large and ever active organization, with marching season/tournaments in the fall and concert/festival season in the spring. Each has specific student, volunteer, and donation needs, and a significant amount of relevant information is distributed throughout the year. To minimize info-overload, various communication sources are used appropriately as needs arise.

To start, three Parent Info Meetings will be held throughout the year to discuss timely topics and upcoming events. The first will be held in early August in the WV Theater. Essential for new parents and a refresher for continuing families, topics covered will include what to expect at the First Day of School Pep Rally, Football Games, the Poway Days Parade, Tuesday Night Practices, and Rehearse-a-Thons. Additionally, you'll want to actively check the GOLD calendar and Facebook, and your student will want to keep tabs on "Announcements." Other important info will be emailed to you via regular Info Sheets and Section Parent Notes. Following is a summary:

Section Parent Notes	Email from Section/Group Parent	As needed.	Elaborates on Info Sheet bullets (Where to meet, what to bring, what to wear, etc.), as well as section-specific info.
Charms	Email directly from GOLD Director or Booster President	As Needed	Important Updates/Info/Requests.

Casual Uniform (provided by student): Casual uniform is worn for school events, parades, some football games: WV Gold Polo (\$37) + Khaki Shorts (\$20-25) (can be ordered in the <u>Webstore</u>), black ankle socks

When to Order: Allow 6 weeks for delivery of WV Gold Polo + Shorts. Order Deadline: July 1 (to receive before school starts) or August 1.

CURRENTLY ON HOLD UNTIL SITUATION CLARIFIES

Formal Uniform (provided by the school): Formal uniform is worn at most football games, tournaments, Disneyland parade. Consists of pants, jacket, shako, gauntlets, gloves. These will be fitted at the end of the school year or during band camp. **CURRENTLY ON HOLD UNTIL SITUATION CLARIFIES**

Under the formal uniform, students wear black athletic or compression shorts or leggings, black T-shirt, long black socks.

For practice (competitive only): black athletic clothing for night rehearsals. WV GOLD, WV or black sweatshirt for identification purposes at tournaments.

Concert Season: December - June

Wind Ensemble (by Audition Only) and Orchestra:

Boys: Black Tuxedo (jacket, pants, white shirt, black bow tie and cummerbund), black socks, black dress shoes. Purchase at store or online. Suggested: 5pc notch lapel Tuxedo Package (Item 79B), Black, \$94, (link)

Girls: Empire Style Black gown with small scoop neckline and 3/4 sleeves, black stockings, black dress shoes. Suggested: Style 4853AX (\$67), (link)

When to Order: Allow 3-4 weeks if ordering from Formal Fashions.

Symphonic Band (most 10-12th grade students) and Concert Band (most freshmen):

Boys: Black dress shirt, black dress slacks and belt, black socks and black dress shoes

Girls: Black dress shirt (3/4 length sleeve or longer), black dress pants or skirt (past knee length), black stockings and black dress shoes

Auditions are required for both Battery and Front Ensemble, and based on not only displayed technical ability, but also attitude and team cohesiveness. Students who do not audition into a drumline position may be placed in the front ensemble and should immediately start attending those rehearsals. You are highly encouraged to explore both options so instructors have a clear idea of what will be the best fit, and placement is at the sole discretion of the Director, not the coaches. Students not auditioning into a Competitive Band spot on either battery or front ensemble will still rehearse with the Competitive percussion section during school and receive the same coaching/curriculum/instruction.

Please bring the following to each rehearsal:

- Athletic clothing (sneakers, shorts/sweats, etc. NO JEANS)
- Sun protection (hats, sunglasses, sunscreen)
- Water (bring more than you think you'll need)
- Snacks for break time
- Assigned music, 3-ring binder (½" or 1" size), highlighter, pencils, drum pad, mallets, sticks
- Have sheet protectors in your binder (music will not be hole-punched)
